CCDC TO HOLD PUBLIC DISCUSSION ON NEXT PRESIDENT *Public Discussion Will Focus on Role and Qualities of Next COO*

SAN DIEGO—Centre City Development Corporation (CCDC) will hold a public discussion regarding the role of and qualities of the next CCDC President and Chief Operating Officer. An Ad Hoc Committee of the CCDC Board, consisting of Jennifer LeSar, Kim John Kilkenny and Janice Brown, will hold the first of several meetings to be scheduled for this purpose on Wednesday, August 20 from 4 to 6 p.m. at CCDC offices.

Under policy direction of the CCDC Board of Directors, the President provides leadership and direction in the planning, implementation, and administration of downtown redevelopment programs and projects. Efforts include the facilitation of retail, residential, office, hotel, cultural, educational and public-improvement projects.

The Ad Hoc Committee welcomes comments regarding the characteristics and responsibilities of the new CCDC President. This input will be considered as the job description is prepared prior to the start of recruitment. Several additional meetings will be held in September for the same purpose.

CCDC is the public, nonprofit corporation created by the City of San Diego in 1975 to staff, plan and implement downtown's redevelopment. CCDC offices are located in the Wells Fargo Plaza Building, 401 B Street, Suite 400, in downtown San Diego.
